AGE:

16+

**TUITION HOURS:**

1 hour/lesson = 60 minutes

**MAXIMUM CLASS SIZE:**

15 students

**PUBLIC HOLIDAYS:**

The school is closed on the following public holidays - when the school is closed on a Monday, new students start on Tuesday.

Monday 2 February; Tuesday 17 March; Monday 6 April; Monday 4 May; Monday 1 June; Monday 3 August; Monday 26 October.

Christmas 2026: 21 December 2026 - 1 January 2027 inclusive.

Christmas 2027: 20 December 2027 - 3 January 2028 inclusive.

**APOLLO STUDENT APP:**

Students can access their personal area of the Apollo Student App by downloading our mobile app from the Apple App Store/Google Play Store. Search for Apollo Language Centre and then log in with your personal details which you will find on your Booking Confirmation Letter.

**PAYMENT:**

Full payment for all programmes is due 2 weeks before arrival. You will find the payment instructions on your invoice.

**CANCELLATION:**

Cancellation 4+ weeks before start date: registration fee of €75 will be charged. Cancellation 2-4 weeks before start date: 20% of the total invoice will be charged. Cancellation within 2 weeks of start date: full amount will be charged.

Where advance payment is made in connection with a visa-required booking, Apollo operates an escrow/delayed payment arrangement with an authorised payments institution or a separate client visa/escrow account with a financial body regulated by the Central Bank of Ireland, as applicable.

Students pay programme fees in advance of making a visa application. These funds remain in the relevant escrow/delayed payment account or client visa/escrow account until the student's visa application has been determined.

If the student confirms that the visa application has been successful, the funds are released to Apollo's current account. If the visa application is refused, a refund will be made less the registration/handling fee of €75. Apollo requires a copy of the official visa refusal document to process the refund. Once the visa refusal decision has been communicated to Apollo and the required documentation has been received, the refund will be processed within 20 working days.
